The Yakima, Washington Police Department Joins CrimeWeb

Yakima, Washington – January 17, 2008 – The 80,000 residents of Yakima, Washington will soon be able to register to receive crime and safety related information directly from the Yakima Police Department. The Yakima Police Department has become the sixth agency in Washington State to join the CrimeWeb Network.

The citizens of Yakima will be able to register for the alerts free of charge, while the department will pay a small yearly subscription fee to upload and distribute information via the CrimeWeb clearinghouse.

About CrimeWeb:

CrimeWeb is a centralized clearinghouse used by public safety agencies across the nation to distribute information to the communities they serve. The patented CrimeWeb process is the most effective method of delivering information to a targeted population of citizens.

Citizens can sign-up for free at www.crimeweb.net and receive specific alert types from any geographical area that interests them. CrimeWeb's patented technology and proprietary zip code engine allows a subscribing agency to distribute alerts anywhere in the country. Alerts can be sent to citizen subscribers in specific zip codes, up to 99 miles around a specific zip code or to all registered users located geographically between two zip codes.
